Hi Tom,

We need to get going on purchasing the 2020 Winter League trophies. I've looked at Acrylic and Glass trophies and they're around \$40/pc. We were thinking a 1st and 2nd place trophy for both gold and silver leagues, so that makes \$40 * 4 = \$160.00 worth of trophies.

We'd also like to make it nice and provide lunch for the teams at the playoff venue. We'll have on the order of 40 or more bowlers there, so if I hit Costco for burgers, fixins, and cookies, it'll probably cost on the order of:

\$60.00	40 people * .5 lb ground beef/person * \$3/lb
\$13.49	Buns @ \$3.49/12 * 4
\$14.97	Potato Salad @ \$4.99/tub * 3 tubs
\$5.98	Ocean Mist Romain Lettuce \$2.99/pkge * 2 pkges
\$12.00	Tomatoes @ \$2.00/lb * 6 lbs
\$7.96	Mayonnaise @ \$3.98/qt * 2 qts
\$6.18	Frenches Mustard @ \$6.18 / 2 bottles
\$16.00	60 piece Costco Cookie Tray @ \$16.00/tray
\$5.99	Dixie Paper Plates 90ct @ \$5.99
\$12.76	Sargento Cheddar Cheese Slices \$3.19/11 slices * 4
\$155.33	Total

Total: \$155.33 (Let's say \$170.00)

So, given that we collected ~\$720.00 for Winter League Entry fees, can the Southwest Division fund \$160 + 170 = \$330.00 for the playoffs?
